Policy Statement

It is the policy of the Regional Municipality of Peel Police Service Board that the requirements set out in this document shall form part of the Board Policies and the Chief of Police is hereby directed to implement and comply with these requirements in the administration and operation of the Peel Regional Police.

1. Policy

It is the policy of the Peel Police Services Board with respect to paid informants and agents, the Chief of Police will:

- (a) Establish procedures and processes relating to the use and management of paid informants and agents;
- (b) Establish procedures on the use of in-custody informants that are consistent with the procedures set out in the Ministry's designated *Ontario Major Case Management Manual*; and
- (c) Ensure that the necessary financial controls and processes for the monetary remuneration of informants and control of funds are in place to ensure the integrity of the police service.

2. Reporting

The Chief of Police shall report those circumstances where the use of paid informants or agents has resulted in an "exceptional" circumstance, or a circumstance which may be detrimental to the police service; and/or where the use of informants or agents has resulted in significant issues of potential liability to the Board and/or the police service.
